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PRESCHOOL TUITION AGREEMENT

For the intent and purpose of this agreement, the buyer shall be referred to as parent [referencing parent(s) or legal guardian(s) of named student] and seller (also known as Creative Frontiers School, Inc.) and shall be referred to as school. Enrollment shall be governed by the terms and conditions set forth in this agreement and in the parents' handbook. If a conflict in terminology exists, this contract will supercede the parent handbook.

Parent promises to pay the school (or any assignee) according to payment schedule set out herein. Schedule (and associated rate) may change if requested by parent in writing and approved by office. Parent promises to pay the school all other amounts as provided in this agreement and agrees to all other terms and conditions of this agreement. If parent defaults in the payment of any installment when due, or if parent fails to perform or observe any part of the parent's contract under this agreement, the school may, at its option without demand or notice to parent, declare the full amount unpaid and due.

Tuition is due either monthly or weekly. If I choose to pay monthly, I understand I must pay before or during the tuition statement. Tuition may also be paid weekly, due on Monday or each specific week. Any tuition account overdue will revert to the higher weekly rate as identified on the current rate sheets. A \$25 bookkeeping fee will be assessed for any account not paid timely. A delinquent payment is subject to a .8333% per month interest charge. In addition, a collection surcharge of 25% may be applied to defaulted accounts defined as any account more than 90 days past due in order to cover the costs of collections. Parent understands that the monthly payment options are an extension of credit. I (we) authorize Creative Frontiers to access my credit report if they deem necessary. School may in its judgment terminate further admission to a student for any non-payment of charges provided for in this agreement or any other, including any charges and fees related to tuition, books, schooling, or related.

Parent recognizes that proper use of school facilities involves some risk or injury to students. Knowing these risks, parent agrees to assume these and hold the school harmless from losses, liability and claims. School provides a student accident insurance policy and benefits are available for school accidents.

The school will be closed and no school will be provided on the following days: Teacher In-Service Days (last three weekdays before Labor Day), Labor Day, Veterans Day, Thanksgiving (and the day after), Christmas,/New Years break (approx. Dec. 24 – Jan. 2), Martin Luther King's Day, Presidents' Day, Easter Break (Thurs/Fri), Memorial Day, and the 4th of July. In addition, there will be no tuition adjustment during any period which the school is closed due to natural disaster or a terrorist attack.

The school does not accept attendance of a child whom, by reason or illness/injury, can't participate in school activities on any given day, or if they present a danger to others.

This agreement is a month to month arrangement that continues until notice is given. Parent(s) have the right to withdraw their child from school at any time, by delivering a 30-day written notice to the office. Parent(s) will be liable for regular tuition through this 30-day period.

This agreement embodies the entire terms and conditions of this agreement. Each party acknowledges they have not relied on any warrants, representations or promises except as set forth expressly, in this agreement. All prior correspondences, memorandums, agreements (whether oral or written) are superseded in total by this agreement. This contract cannot be modified orally. Any modification must be in writing and signed by all parties hereto. If any provision of the agreement is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, void, or unenforceable, remaining provisions shall continue in full force and effect.
